

**Jim Matteo • Vice President for Finance and Treasurer, Princeton University**

Jim Matteo is Princeton's chief financial officer, responsible for the central financial functions of the University. As the official custodian of Princeton's financial records, he leads and oversees the offices of treasury services, budget, controller, financial systems, payroll, purchasing, risk management, and tax. He is a member of the University Priorities Committee and partners with campus leaders on resource and financial management issues and planning. He is an ex officio member of the Princeton University Investment Company board. Before coming to Princeton, Jim was the University of Virginia's associate vice president and treasurer responsible for debt and liquidity management, enterprise risk management, and foundation relations. Prior to that he worked in the internal audit and finance divisions at PPL Corporation in Allentown, PA.



Jim is board chair of the Treasury Institute for Higher Education. The recipient of a National Association of College and University Business Officers (NACUBO) Rising Star Award, he served on the organization's Research Universities Council, Awards Council, and the advisory board for the NACUBO-Commonfund Study of Endowments. Jim has also served on the SACUBO Research Universities Constituent Committee and participated in the EACUBO mentoring program.
